ORDER

1. On May 12 , 2025, the Office of the People’s Counsel for the District of Columbia (“OPC”), on behalf of Complainant Rebecca Levinson, filed a Motion for an extension of time to file its post-prehearing conference brief until May 29, 2025.¹ OPC states that it requires the additional time because certain data for download from Respondent Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”) has not yet been delivered to Complainant.² OPC requires receipt of the data to formulate its analysis.³ OPC asserts that the extension will not prejudice the interests of any party to the proceeding.⁴ Pepco does not object to the Motion.

2. Inasmuch as OPC has shown good cause for the extension and that granting the extension will not prejudice the interests of the opposing party, the Motion is **GRANTED**. OPC shall file its brief by May 29, 2025; and Pepco shall file its response by June 9, 2025.

3. The Commission Secretary shall serve this Order on the Parties.
